




Thinking of their next car purchase, as regards fuels, Greeks would consider











The vast majority—almost all—express both advantages/motives and disadvantages regarding electric cars


Disadvantages center around three main subjects:

How does Greeks' opinion compare to that of Europeans regarding electric cars?






The attitudes of Europeans towards electric cars is quite similar to that of the Greeks: advantages
