YouGov Profiles, a new National Syndicated Survey has been launched in Greece by Focus Bari & YouGov in the Fall 2021. Profiles runs on a continuous basis, recording thousands of parameters regarding the Greek population, such as attitudes, opinions and perceptions on brands, consumption habits, hobbies and interests, usage of technology, personality characteristics, lifestyle, usage of media, etd. Profiles is heavily used by advertisers and agencies, in order to allocate, understand and reach appropriate target audiences for brands and campaigns.



In view of Saint Valentine's Day, we chose to focus on Greeks' attitudes to Love and Marriage through their agreementdisagreement to the following statements:


- I am a hopeless romantic



Women seem a little more romantic than men, and so are (marginally) the 25-44 age groups and inhabitants of Attica and the provinces






Neither agree, nor disagree



When compared to men, women seem to be less attached to a relationship in order to be happy!
















## As is natural, married relate their happiness to their relationship much more than "singles" do






Interestingly, men view this mutual "treatment as equals" to a higher degree than women, although they both refer to the same thing







One out of two Greeks say it is important for their family to approve of their partner, and only one in five say the opposite!















«It is important to me that my family approve of my partner » %

Women seem to depend on their family's approval of their partner more than men say they do!

















«Marriage is an outdated institution»

Younger ages agree to a higher extent than older ones that marriage is an outdated institution













## Obviously, the group of "singles" believe that marriage is an outdated institution to a much higher degree than the married ones
