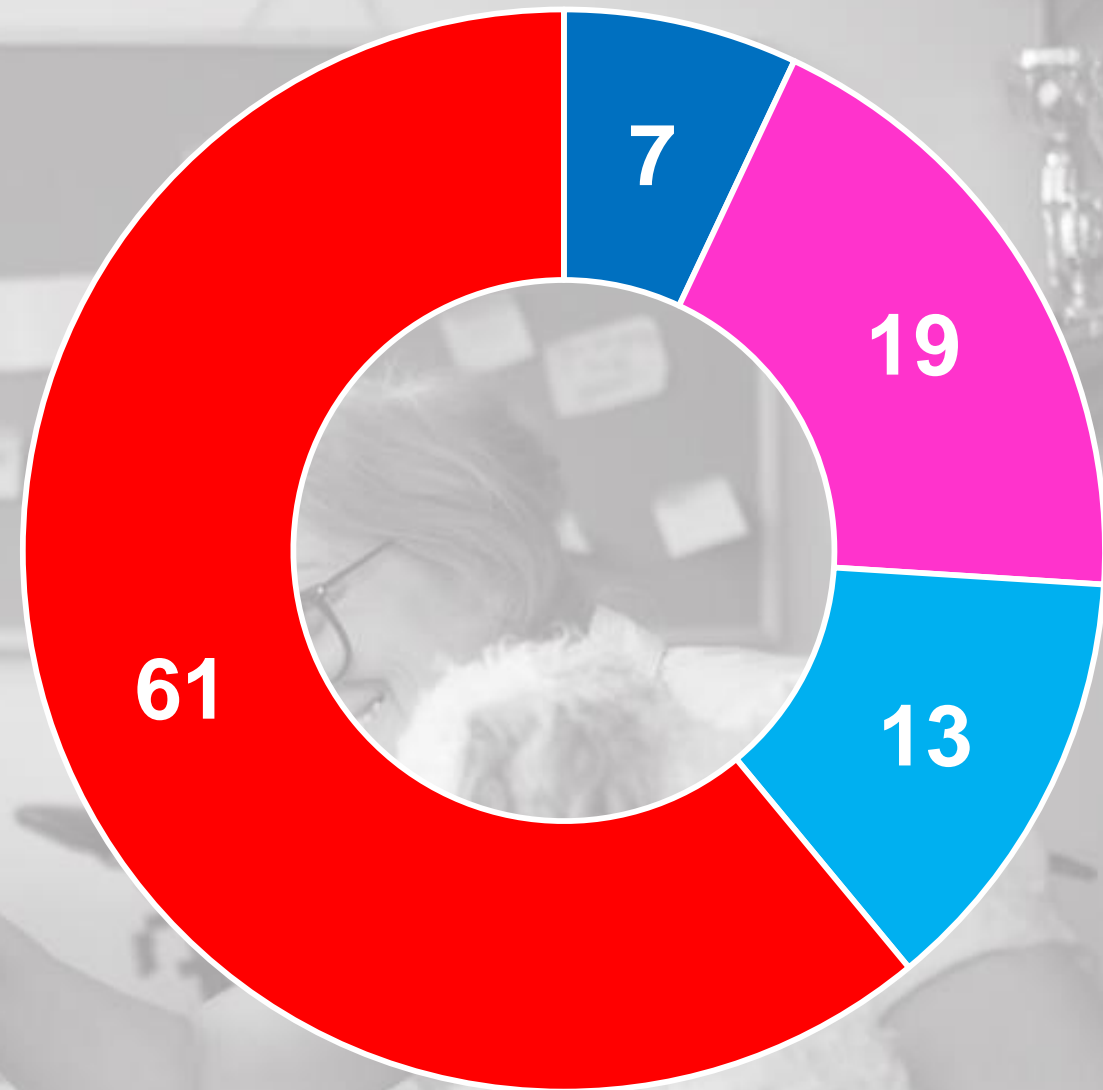

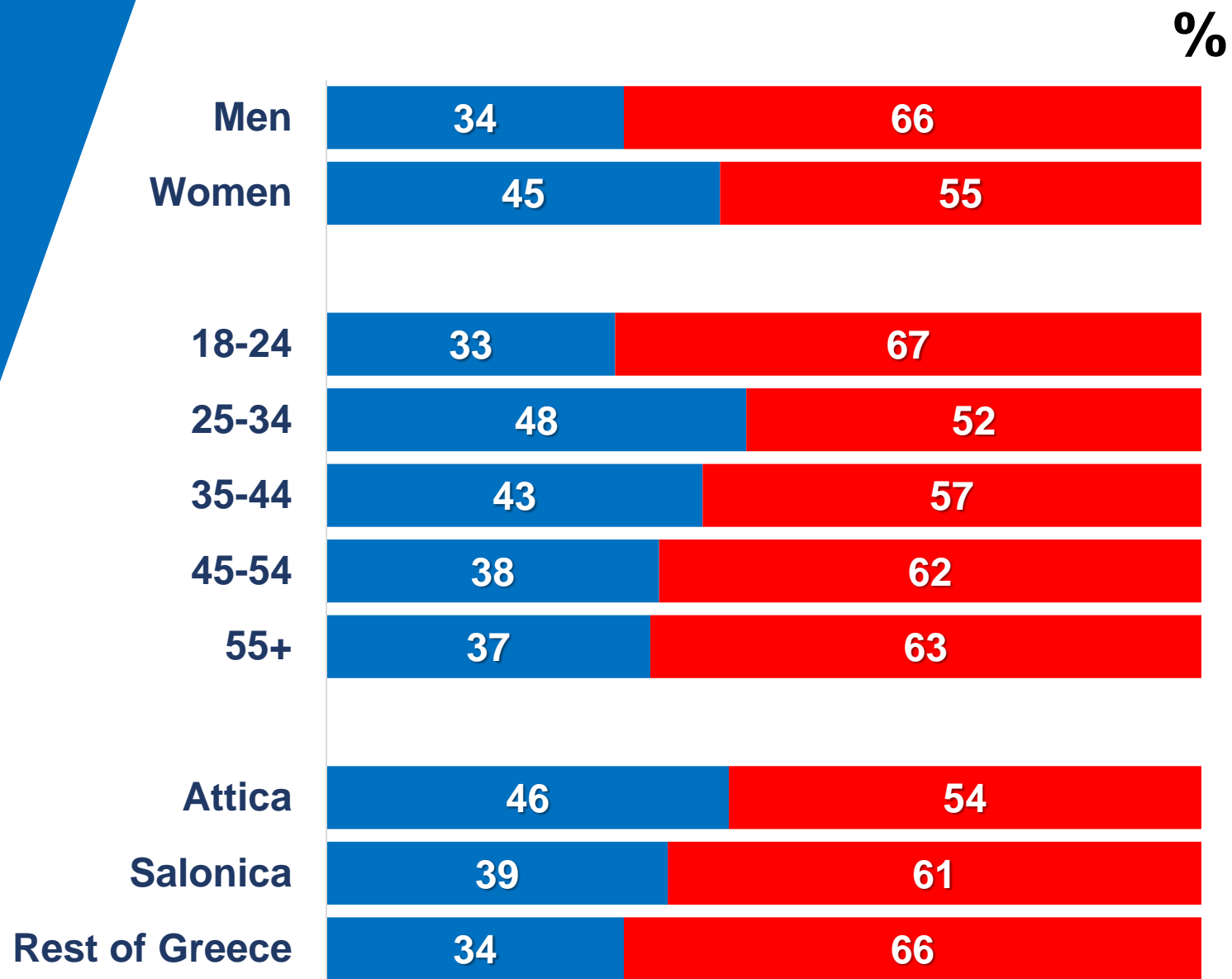


Two out of five

two years

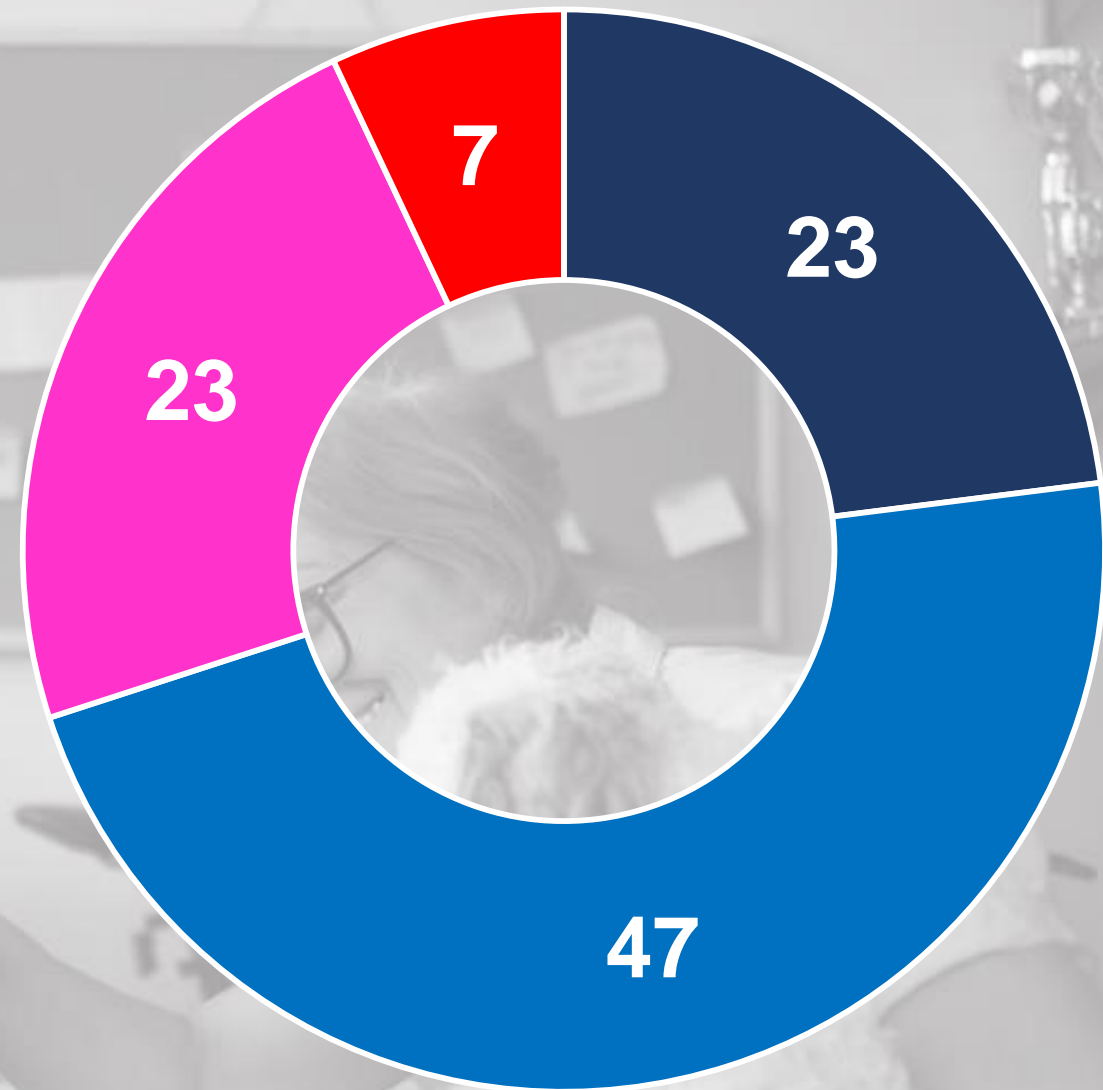


- I work remotely from March 2020 until today
- I worked remotely only during lockdown periods
- I worked remotely during lockdowns and currently some days per week
- I have not worked remotely at all during the last two years

A higher proportion of remote work is found among women, the 25-44 age groups, and Attica

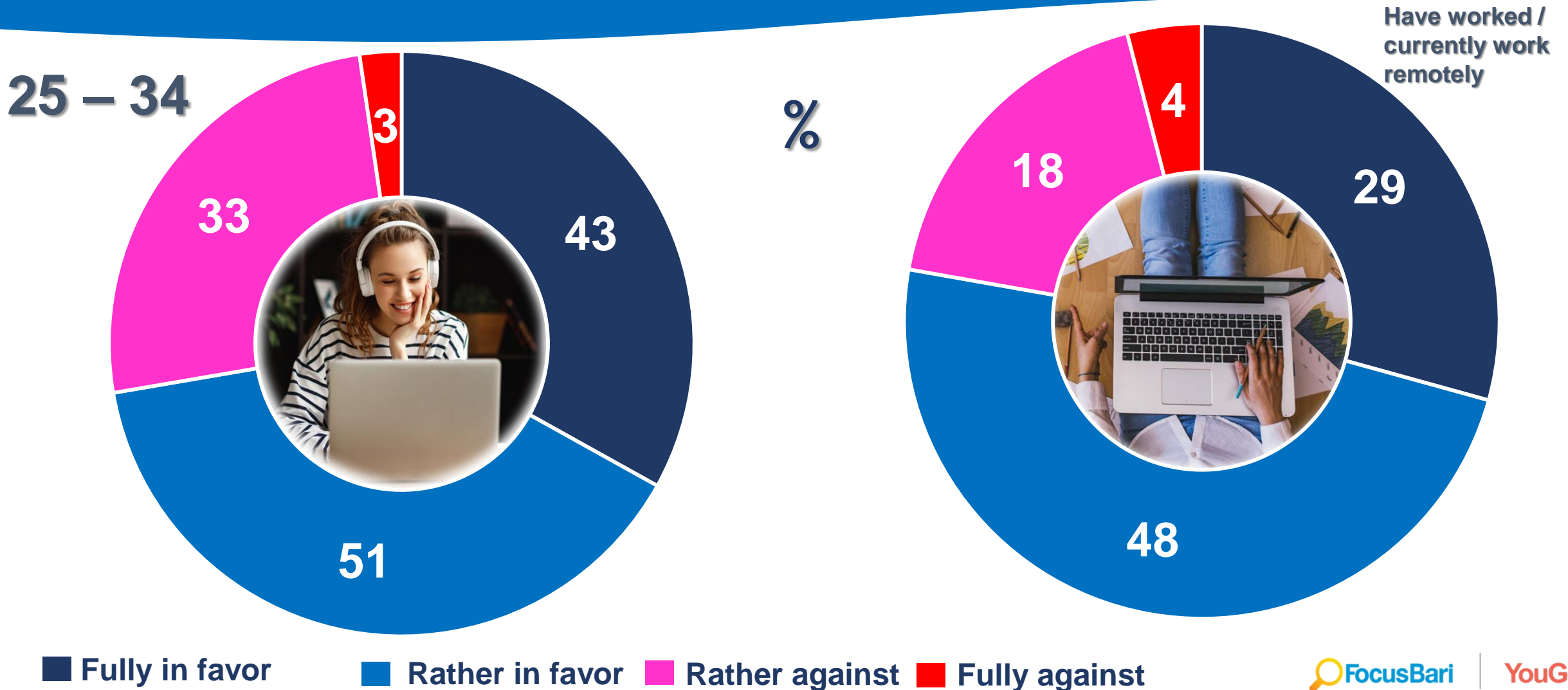


Seven out of ten

of remote work

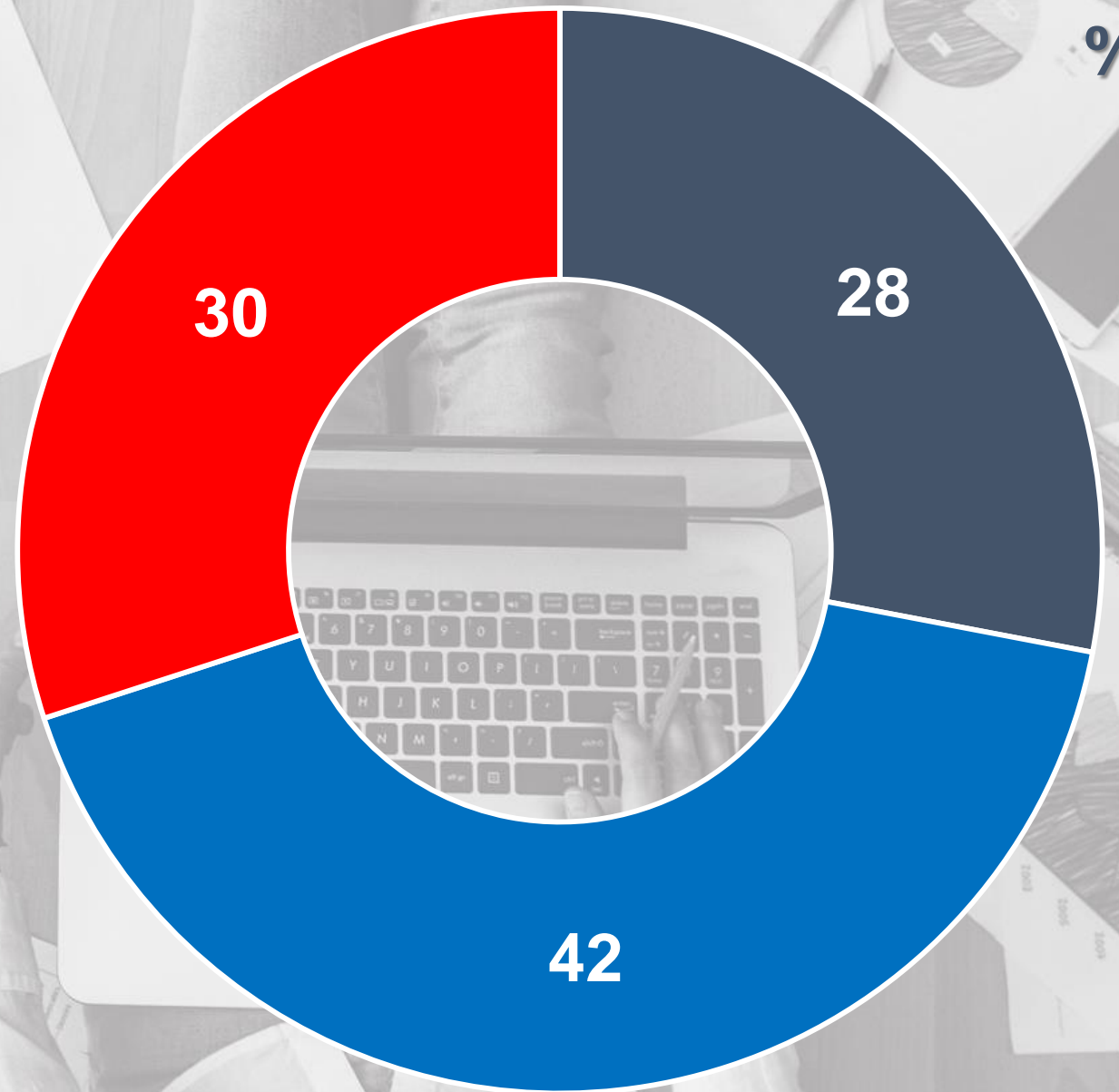


- I am fully in favor of remote work
- I am rather in favor of remote work
- I am rather against remote work
- I am fully against remote work

Particularly positive in favor of remote work are the 25-34 age groups and those who have worked or currently work remotely



For the majority of Greeks, remote work is positively accepted depending on the nature of work, and provided it is mutually decided and beneficial for both employees and businesses



- I am 100% in favor : an excellent solution for both employees and businesses
- A solution that should be mutually decided between employee and business
- It has been a necessary/obligatory solution only during the pandemic

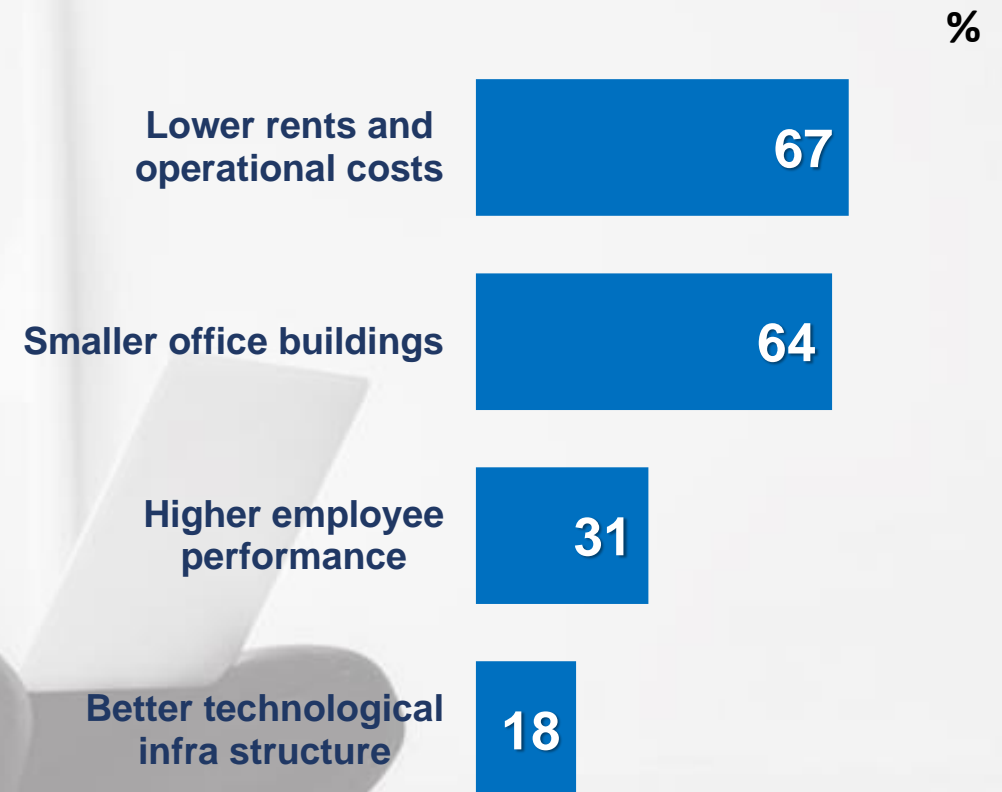

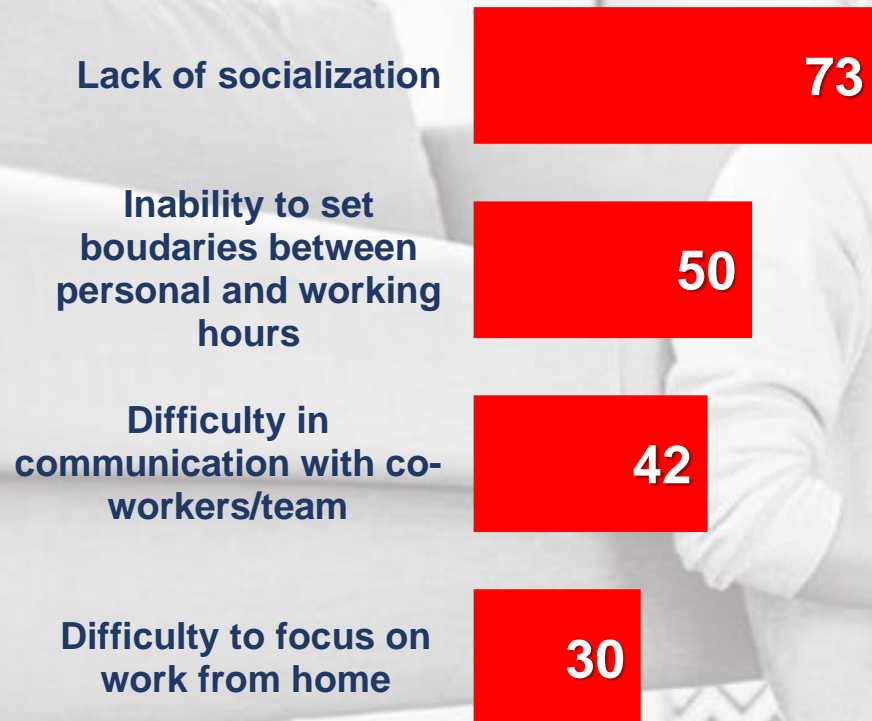
## Benefits for businesses

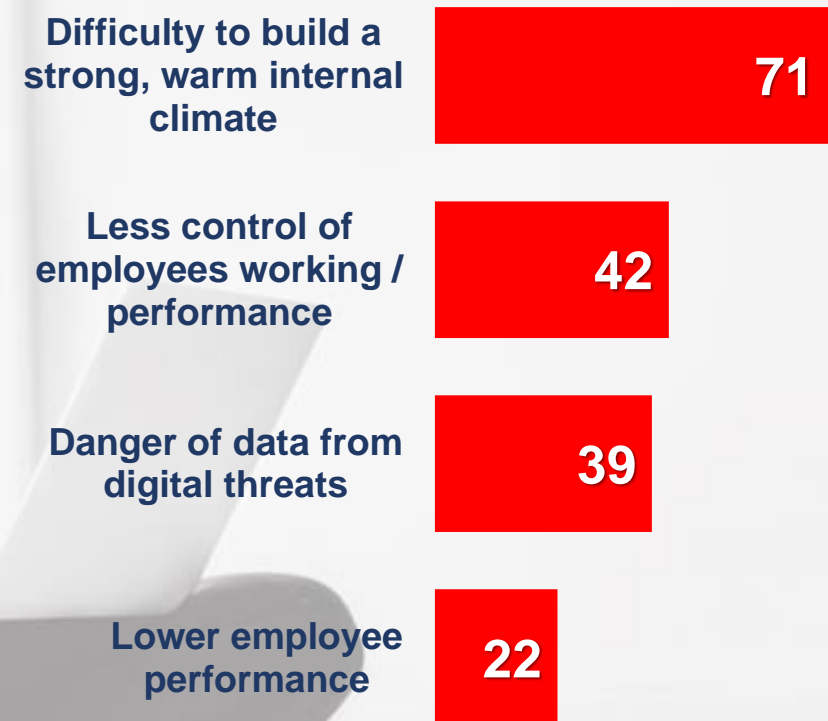
## Drawbacks for employees

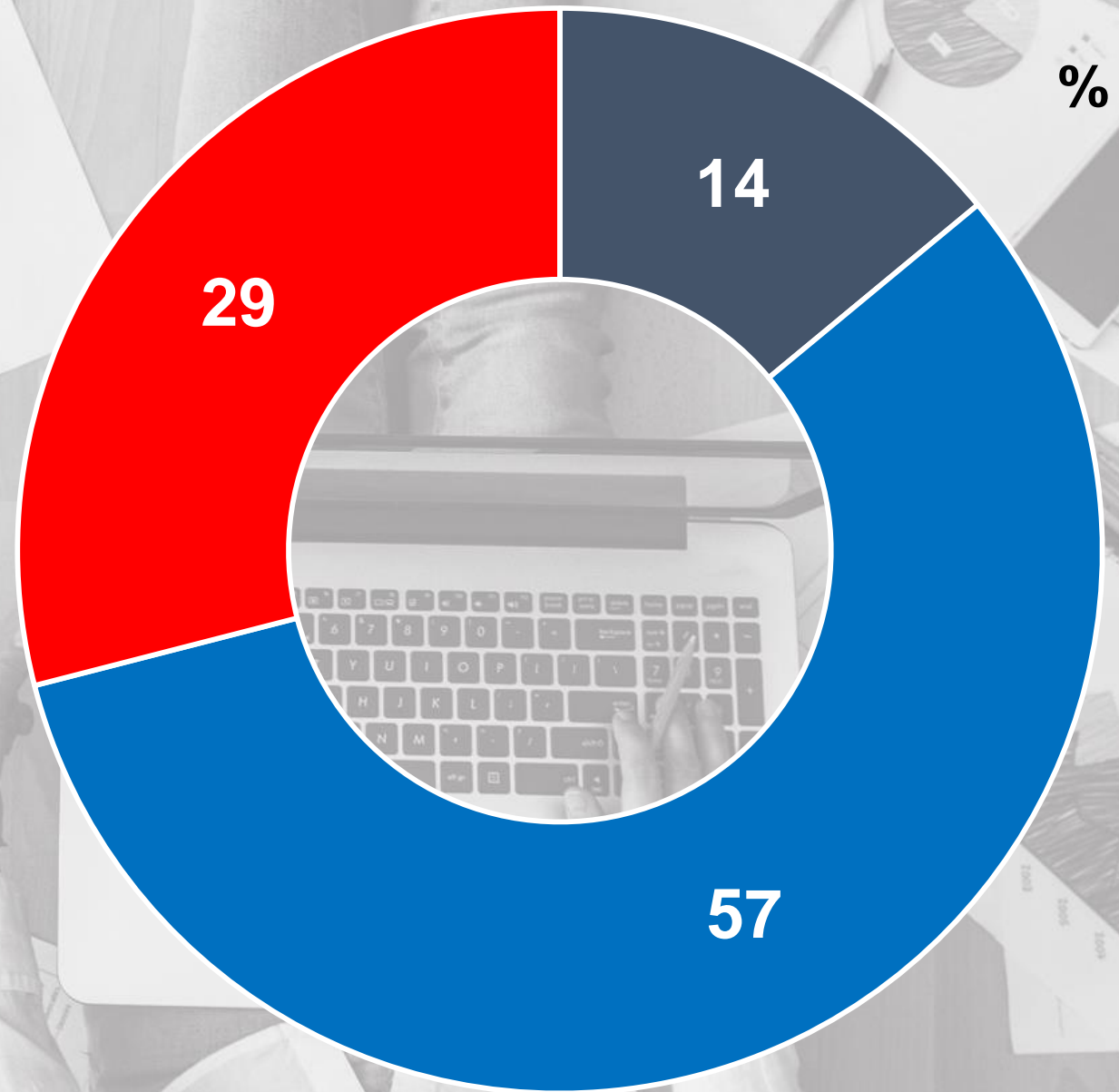


## Drawbacks for businesses
