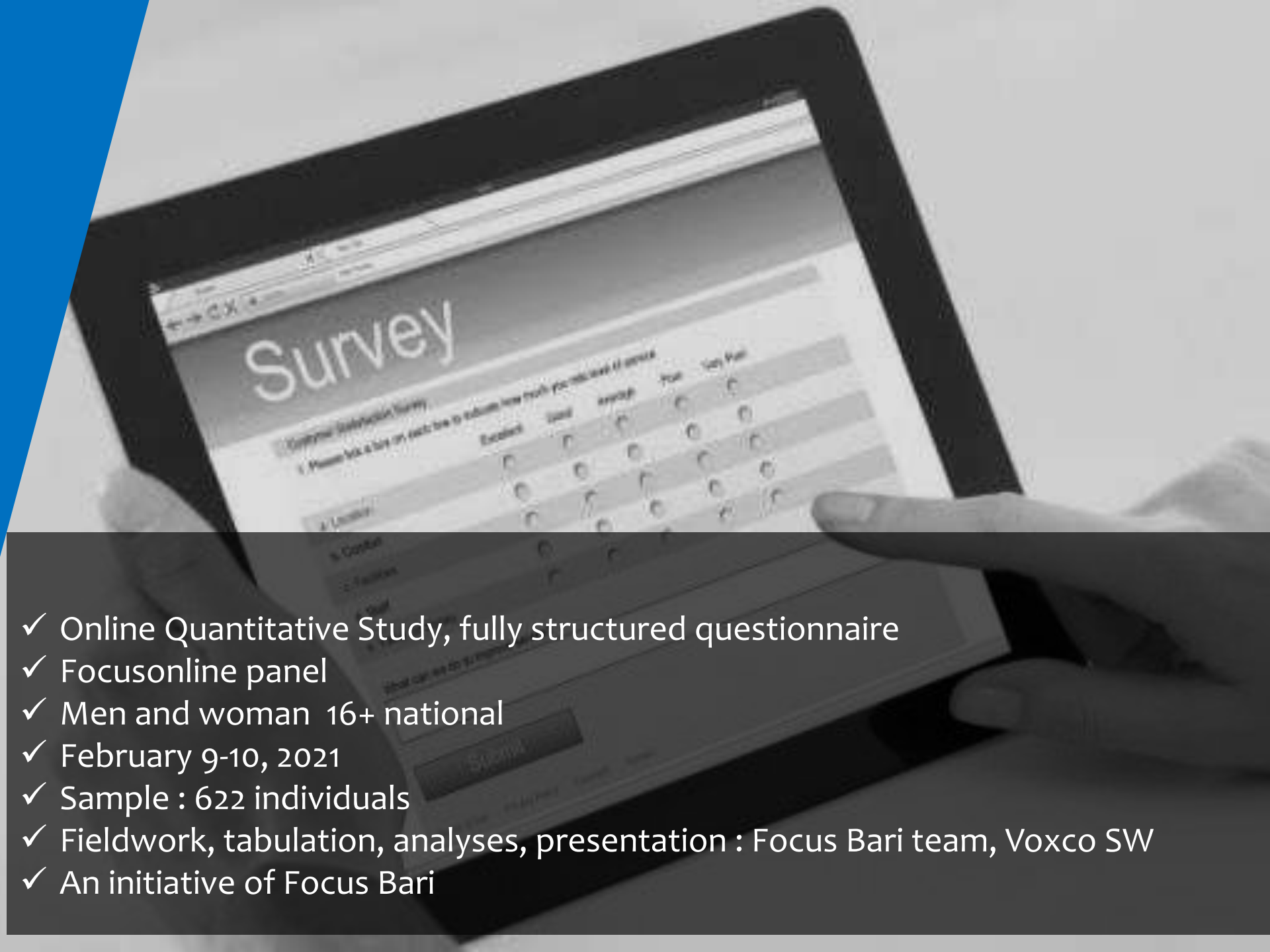

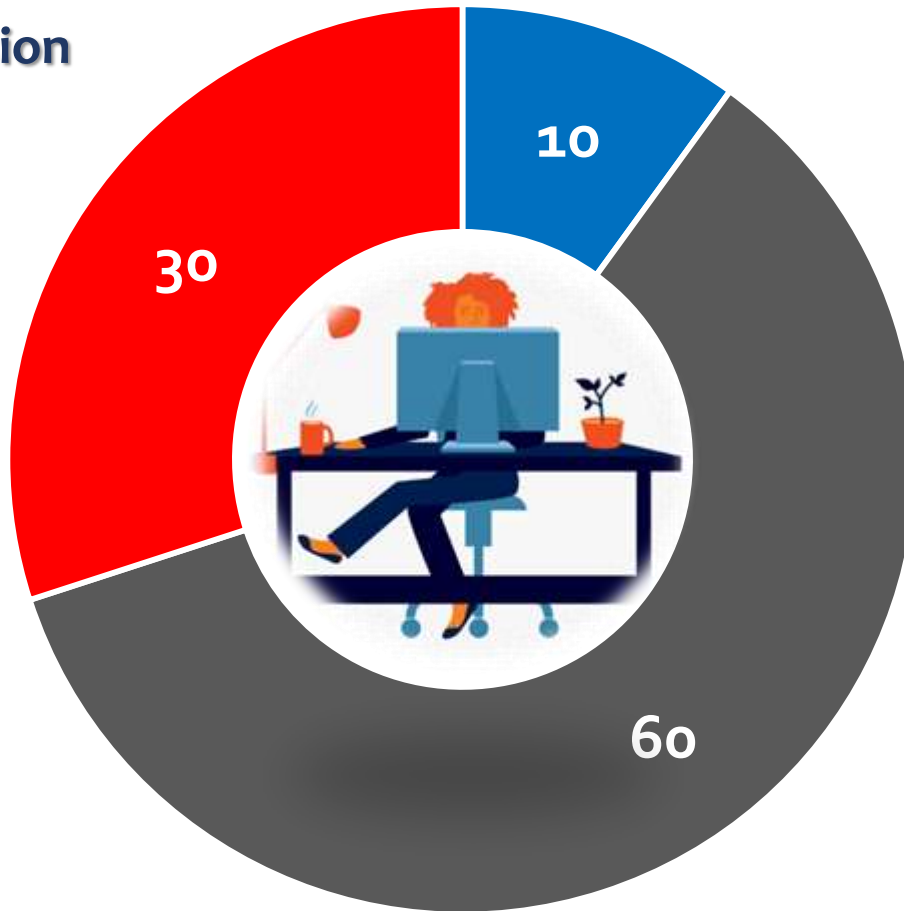

Profession

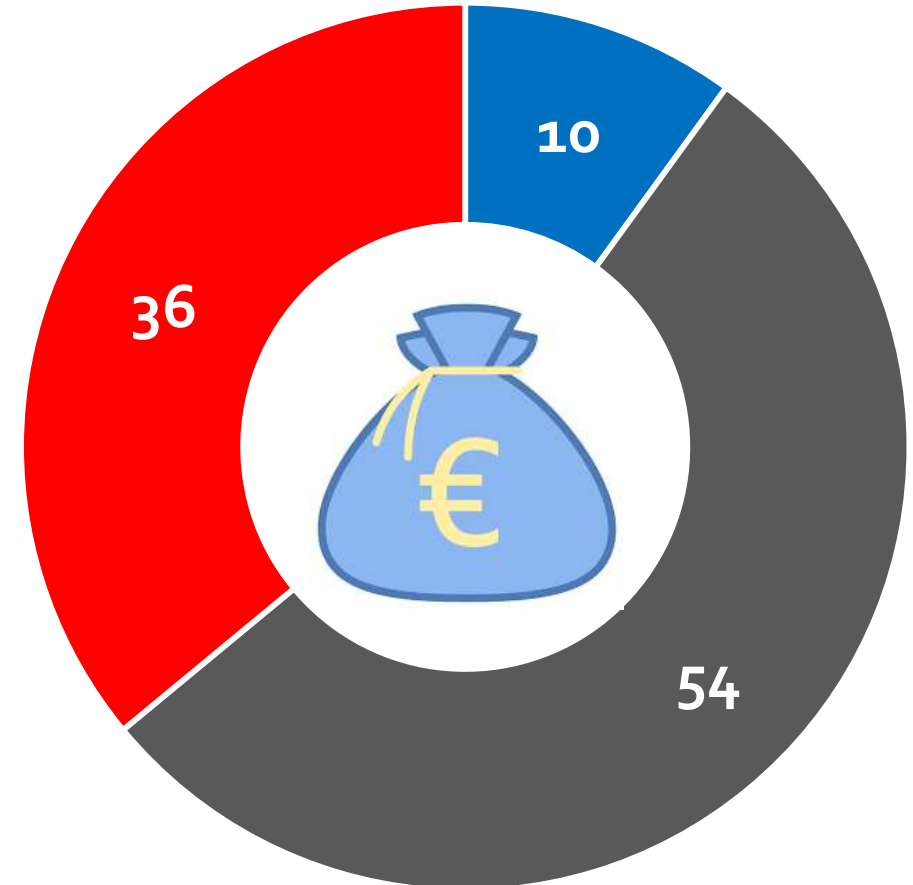


■ Better status

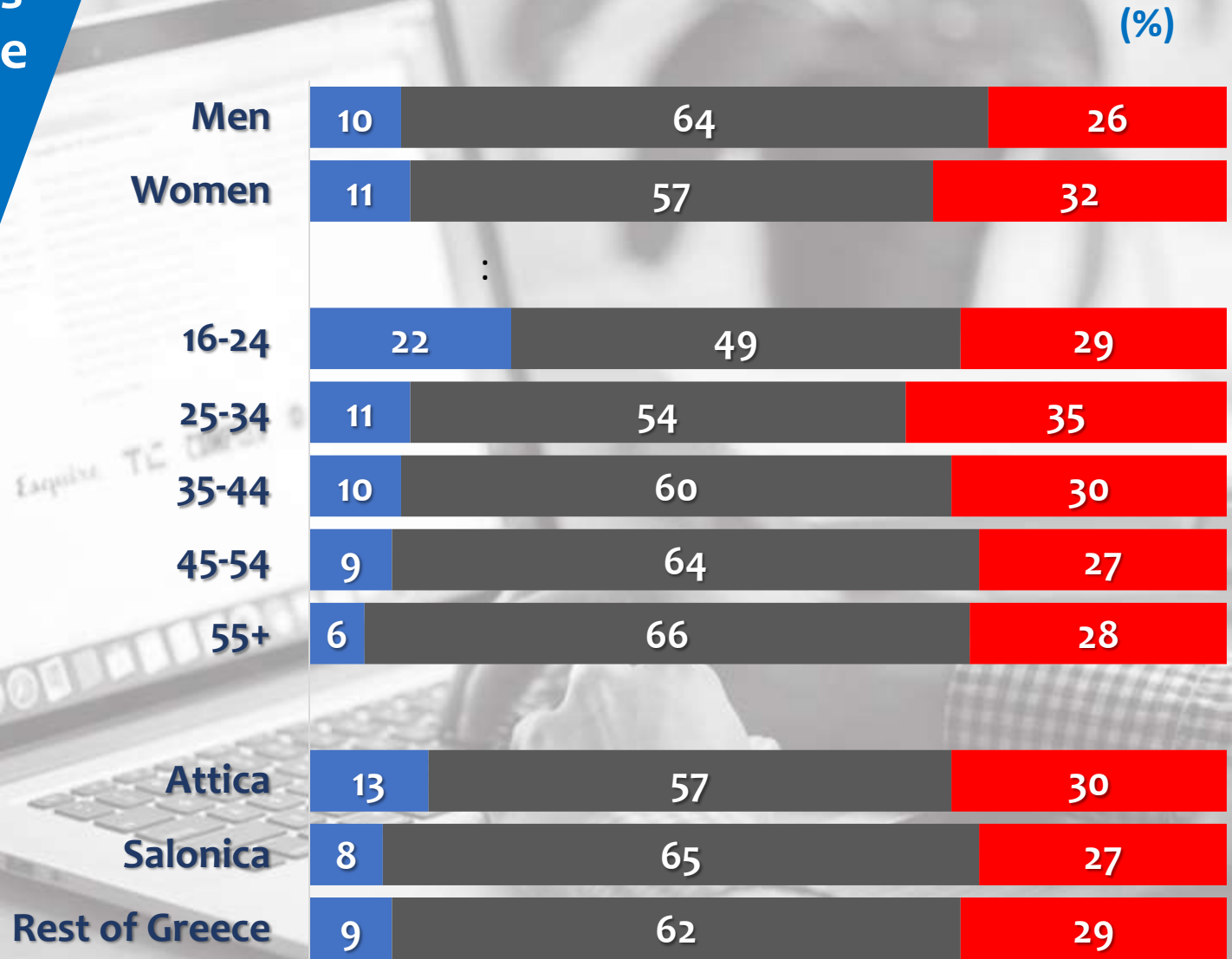

The ratio between Greeks who report a worse professional status versus last year and those who report the opposite is **three to one**, with **three out of ten** Greeks stating their professional situation **has gotten worse** during the pandemic year.

**Two out of three** report the same professional status as one year ago.

The age group showing the highest proportion of an **improved** professional status is the **youngest** most probably due to their **digital savviness**



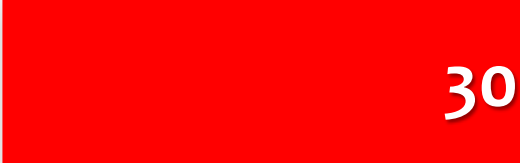

**Among the three out of ten Greeks who report a worse professional status after 12 months of covid-19 conditions, the main reasons are:**

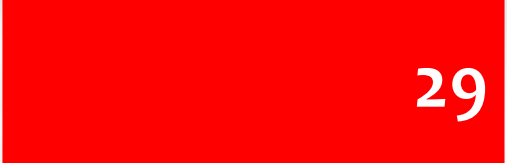


**My business has under operated for long periods of time due to the pandemic**

**I am unemployed/the company I worked for is closed during pandemic/had to reduce personnel**



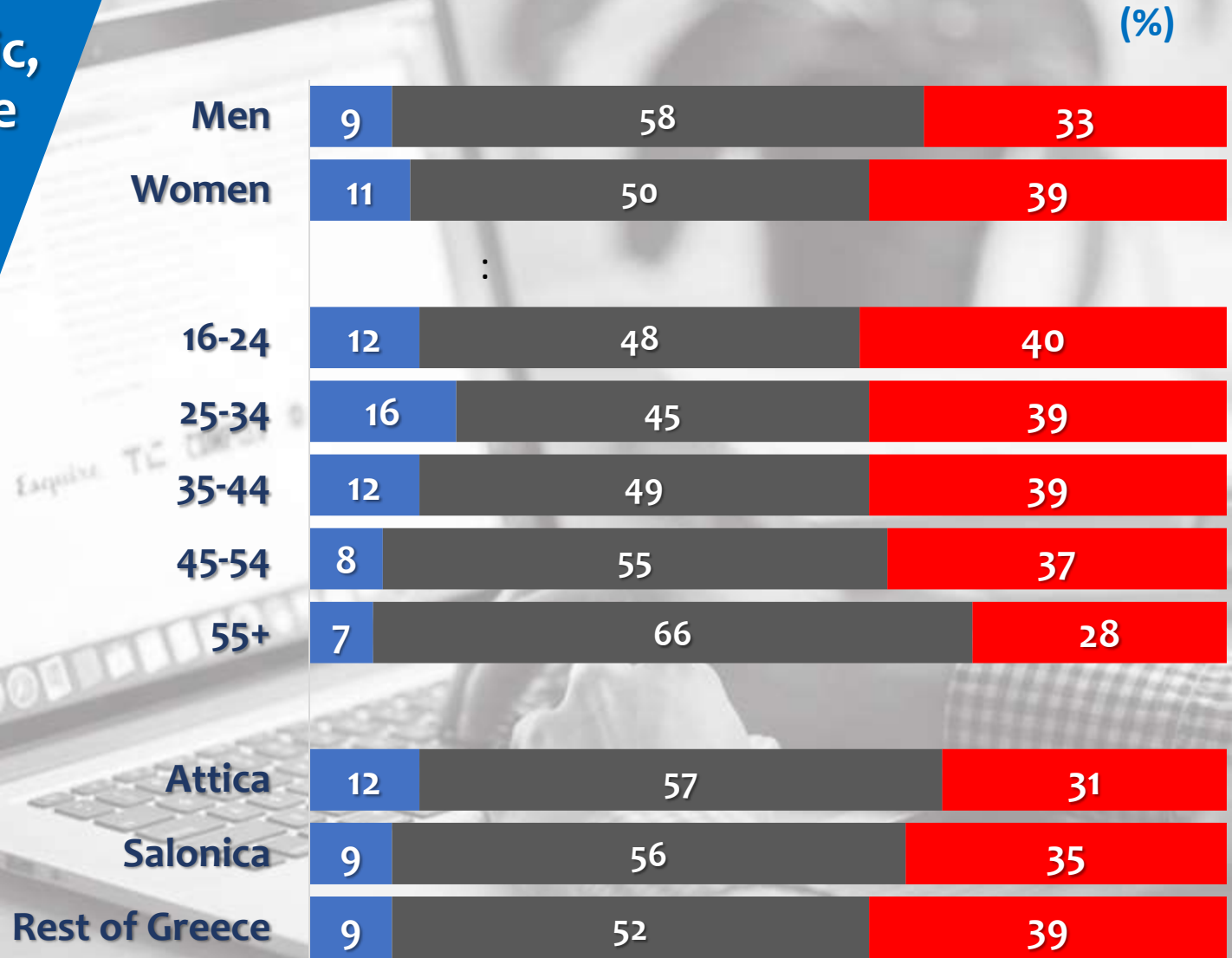
**The company I worked for closed down permanently**



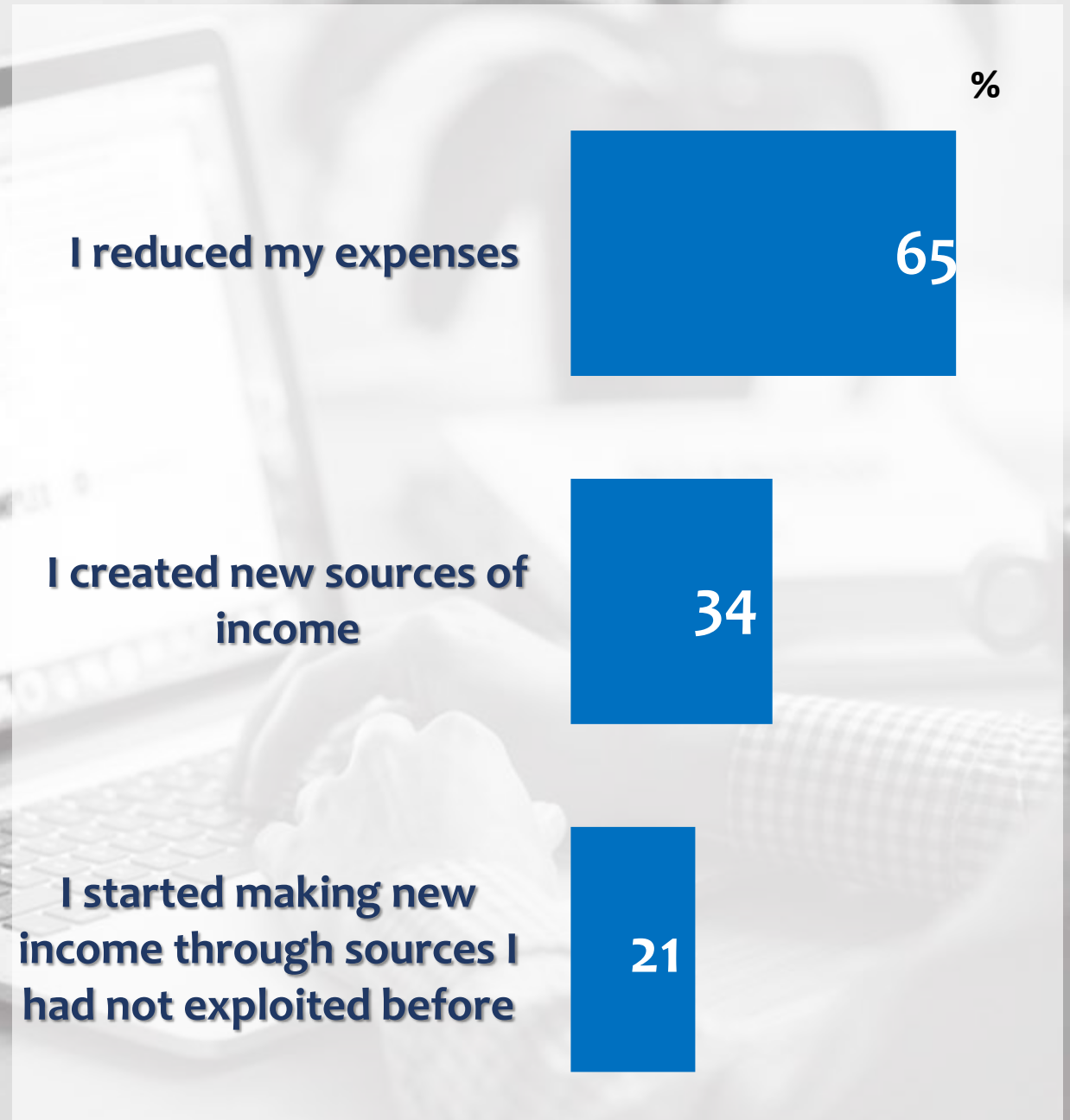
**Over one out of three** Greeks state their financial status **is worse** one year after the start of the pandemic, while those who state the opposite are less than one in ten!

**Same financial status** as 12 months ago is reported by almost **three out of five** Greeks.

A marginally **better** picture as regards financials now versus last year is noted among the **55+** years of age, and In **Attica** as compared to Salonica and the rest of Greece

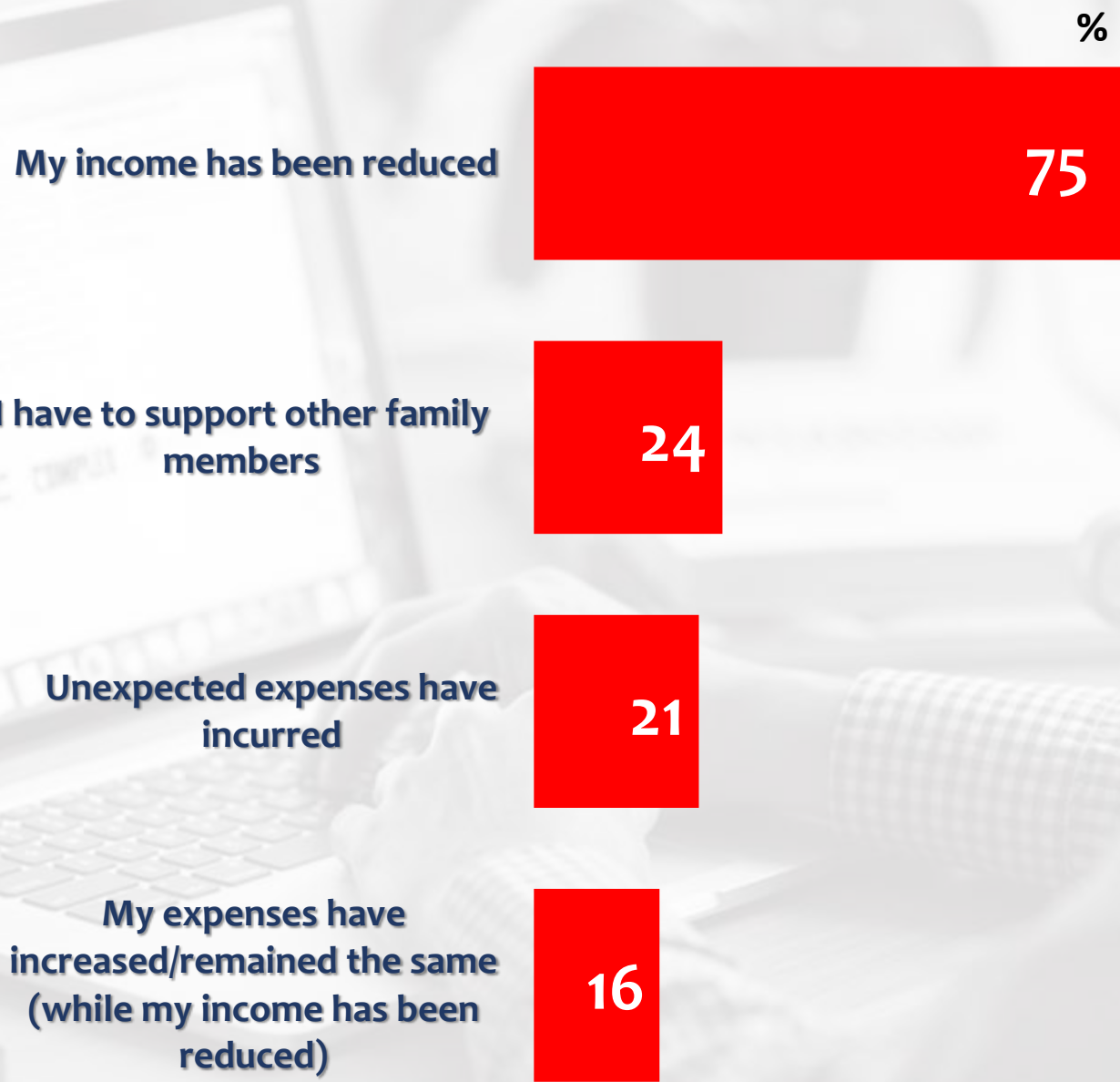


For the limited proportion of Greeks who report a better financial status 12 months after the start of the pandemic, the main reasons are:
