The pioneering study!


- The international network of independent research companies IRIS (International Research Institutes), of which Focus Bari has been a member since 1991, designed and implemented this study on its own initiative.
- The study concerns the "dreams and ambitions/expectations" of different peoples in relation to their current daily life and their future desires.
- The research was conducted in 17 countries, and in this report, key findings are presented both from Greece and internationally.

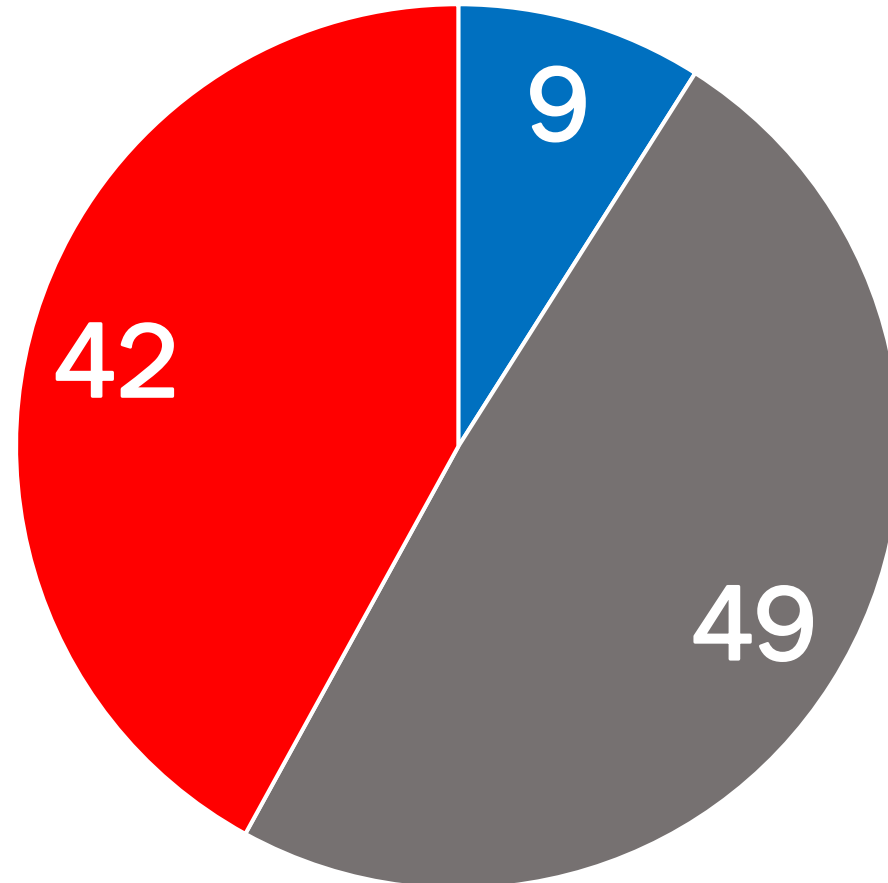

Daily Life : Attitudes, Dreams & Goals

Only one in ten Greeks feel happy with their current daily life!

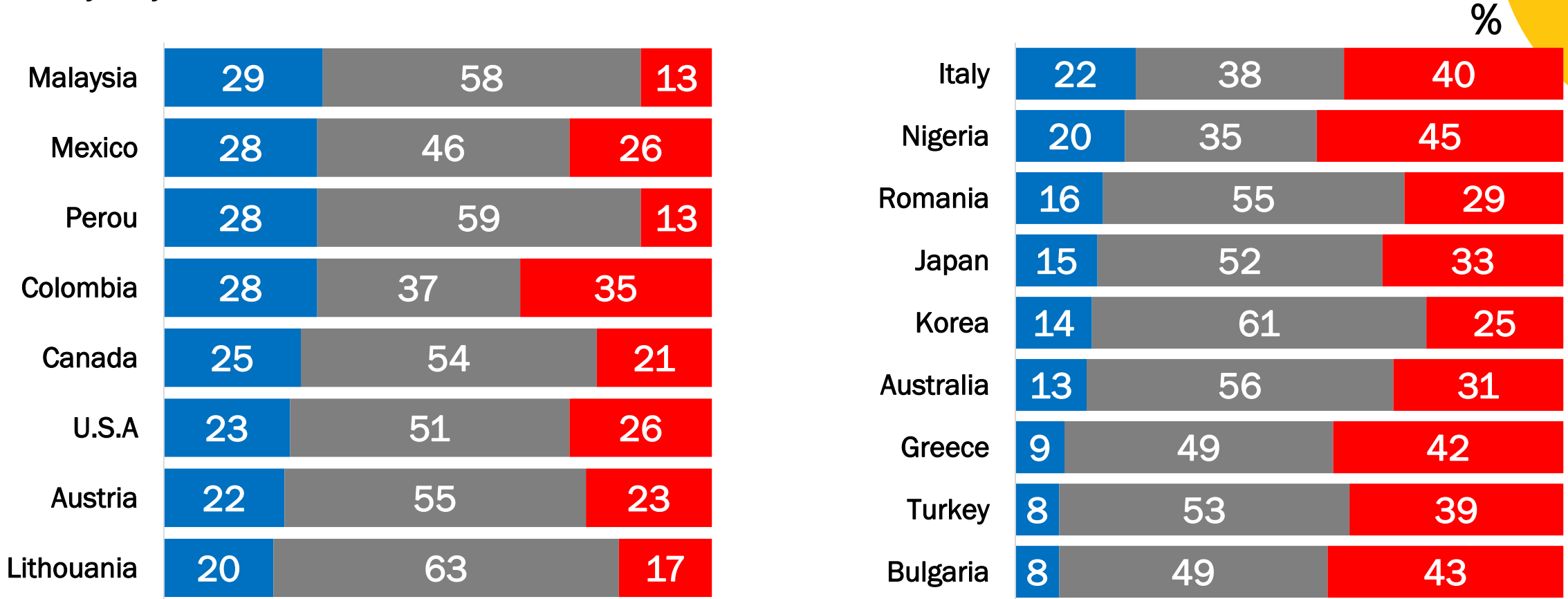
«How distant does your current daily life feel from your aspirations, from very far away to very close to achieving them?» (scale 1-6) %

Across nations, citizens' daily life seems to be quite far from their dreamlife, with significant differences between countries

Nations' dreams & aspirations were recorded in their own words, and for Greeks, their goals & desires center around :

Qst“. We are interested in understanding the aspirations of Greeks (i.e. desires, goals, ambitions). Please share with us your main aspiration” (open ended)

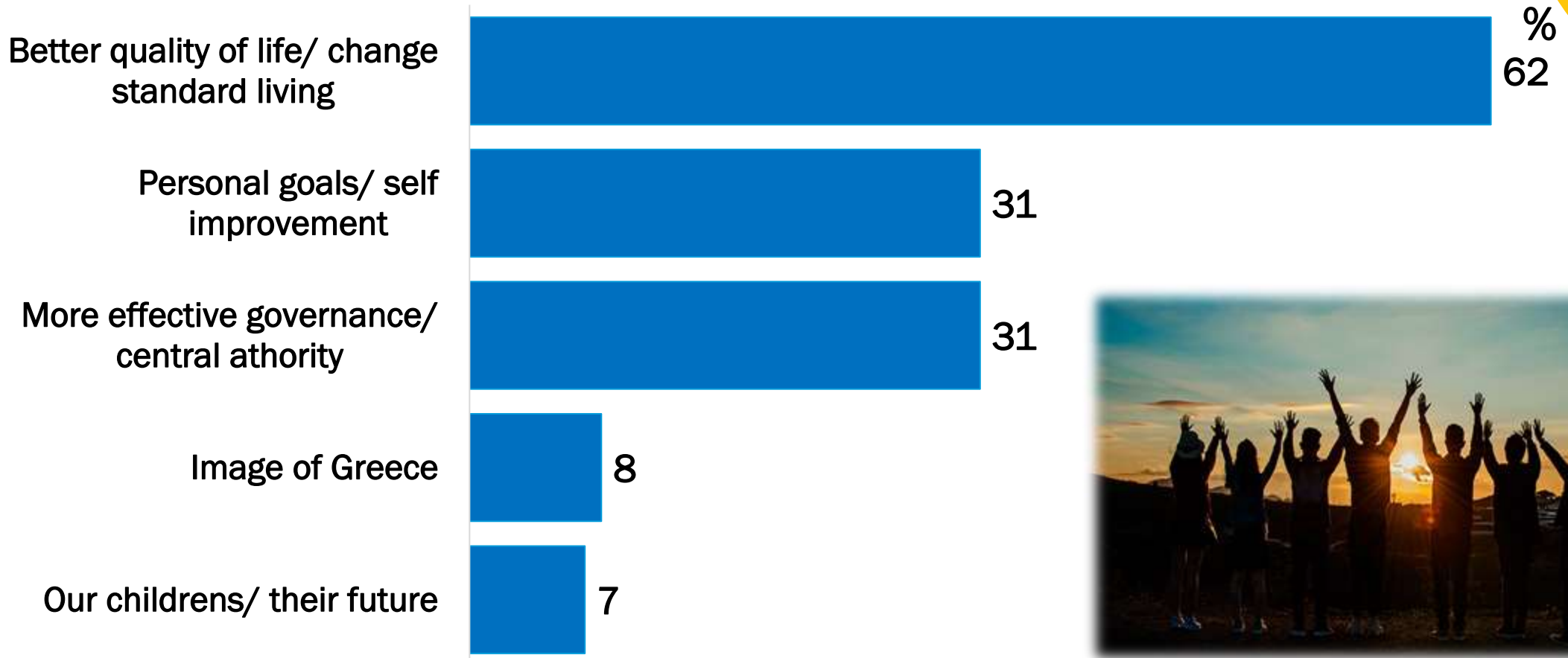

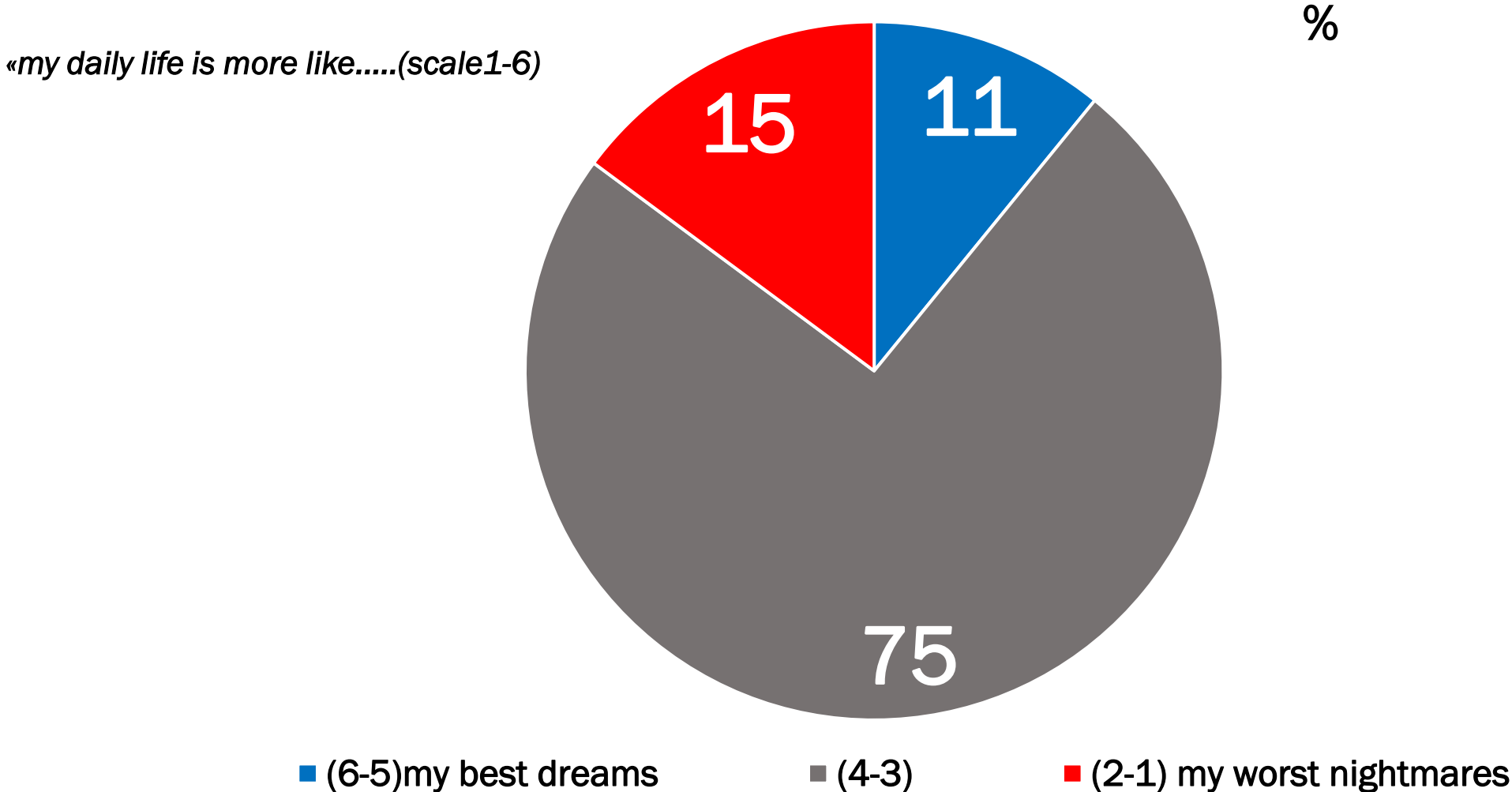

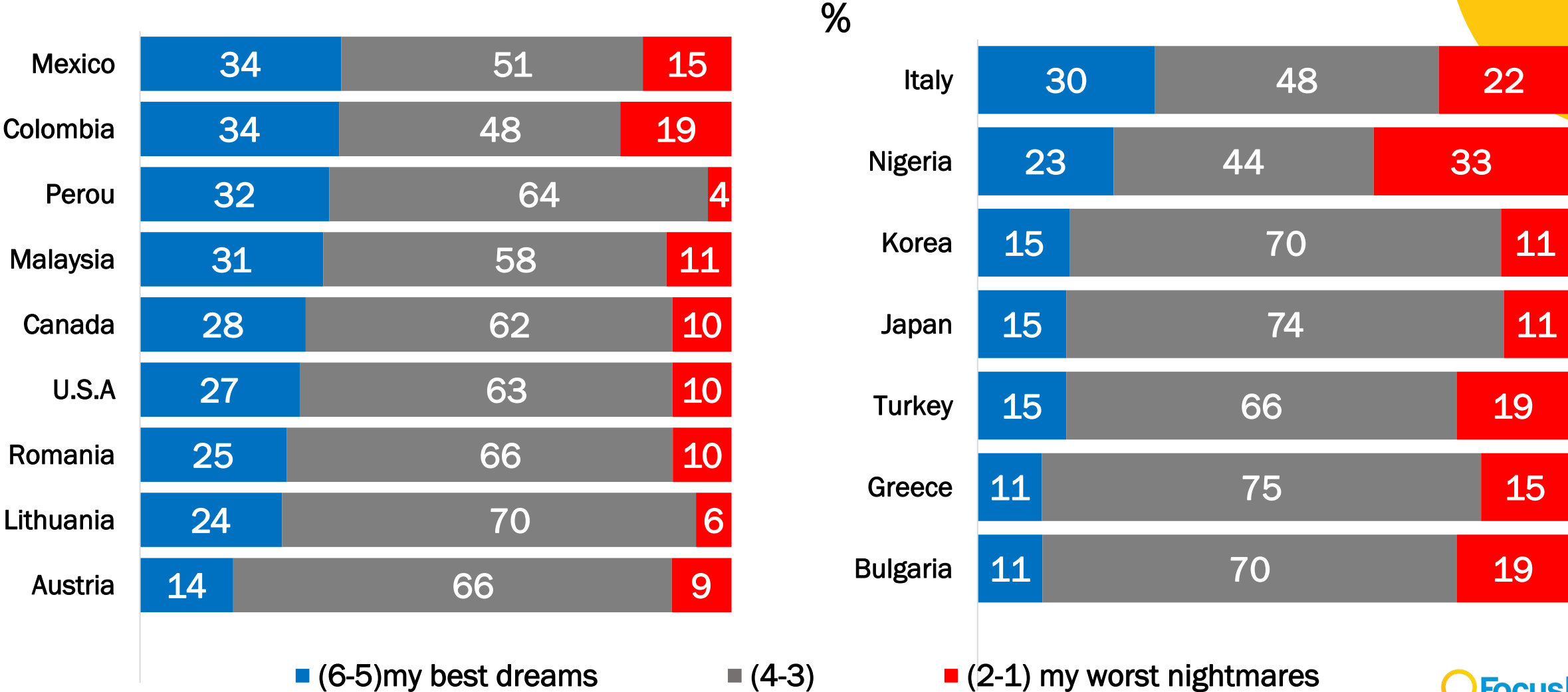
Results show that Quality of life and improvement of their financial status are the main dream/desire of the Greeks



Is daily life a dream or a nightmare? Three out of four Greeks position themselves somewhere in the middle:



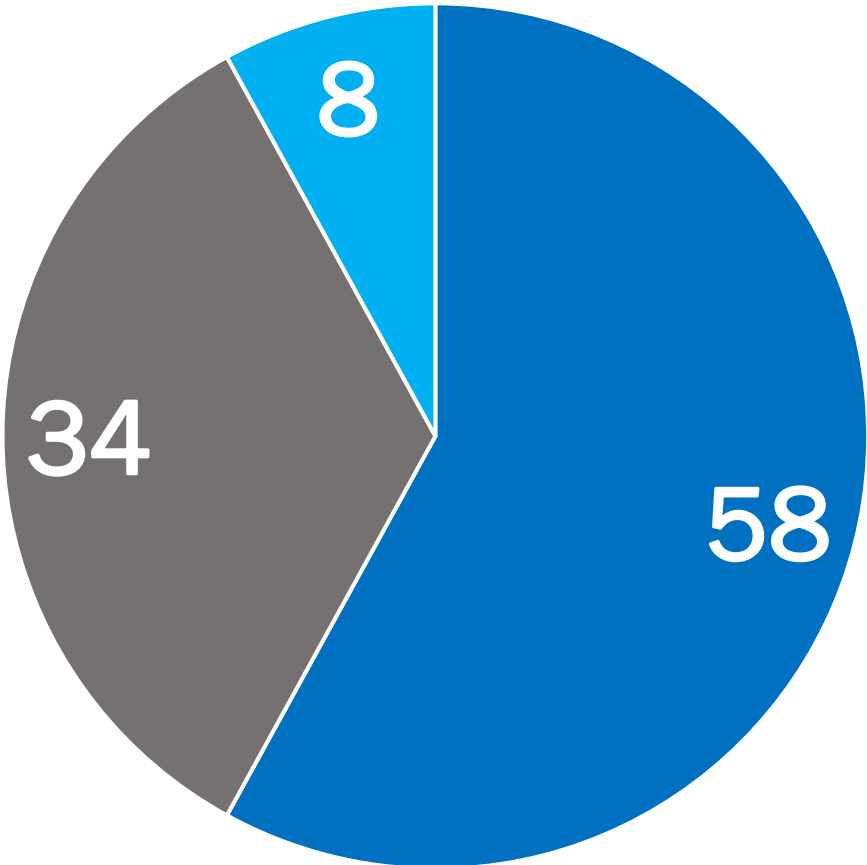
The degree of happiness—stated as the difference between actual and desired—varies between countries and has no correlation to financial/economic status

Three out of five Greeks believe that the state should put priority on citizens' welfare rather than on its international position / influence

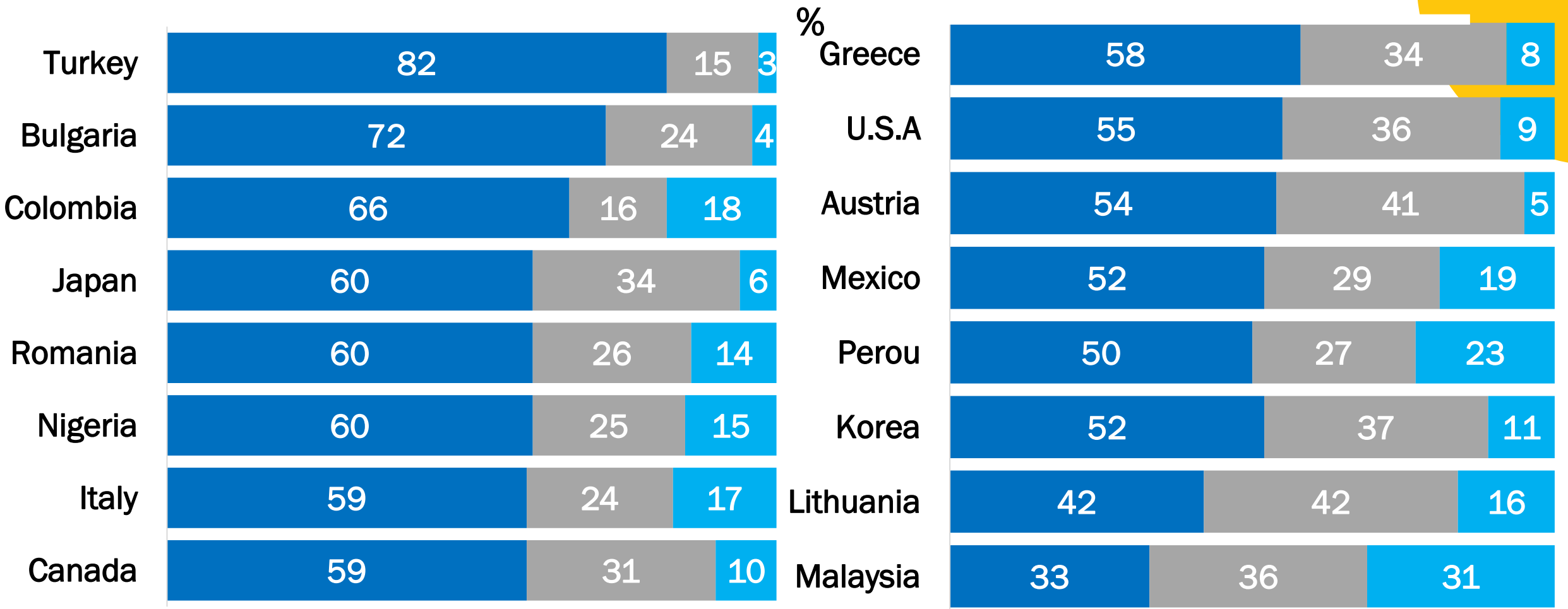
Qst. On the following scale, what do you consider more important for Greece to do? (scale 1-6)

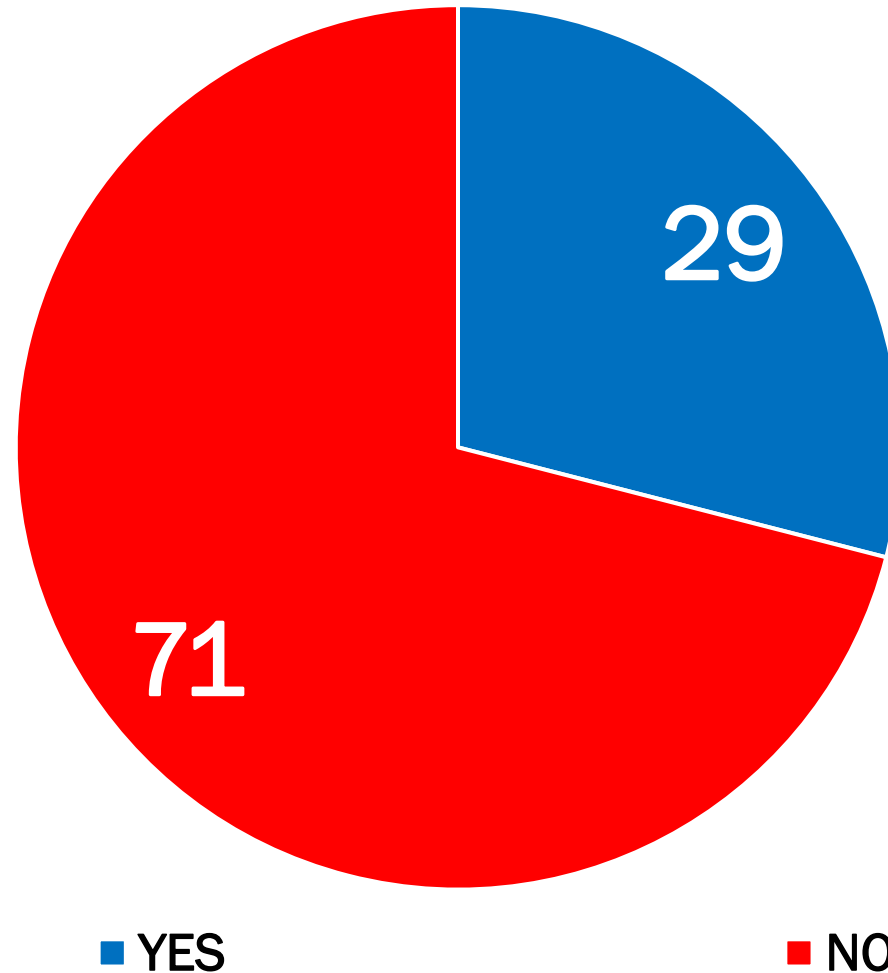
Common Dream among Citizens of each Country

Seven out of ten Greeks believe that we don't have a common dream as a nation!

The Greeks express demands towards their country, considering that its strong moral system has been lost. They expect Greece to highlight its history and values so that they can feel secure and proud.

Qst. "Do you believe that Greeks have a common dream?"

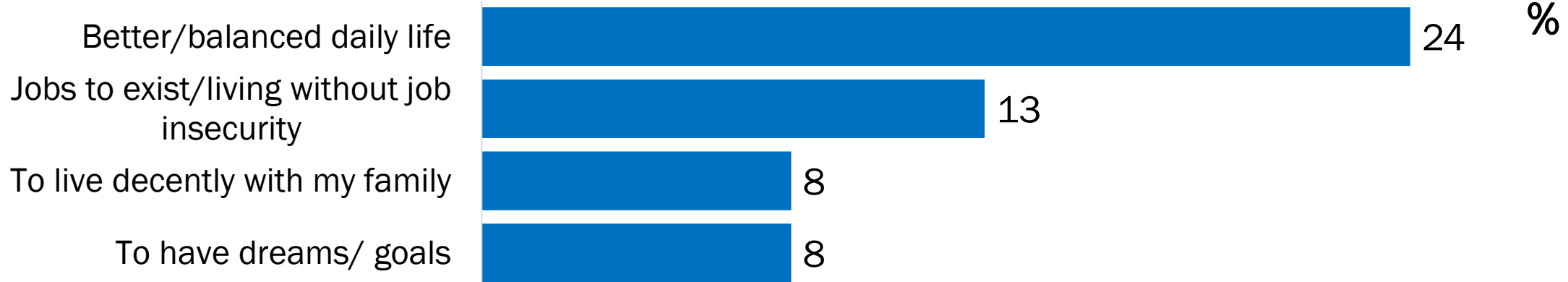

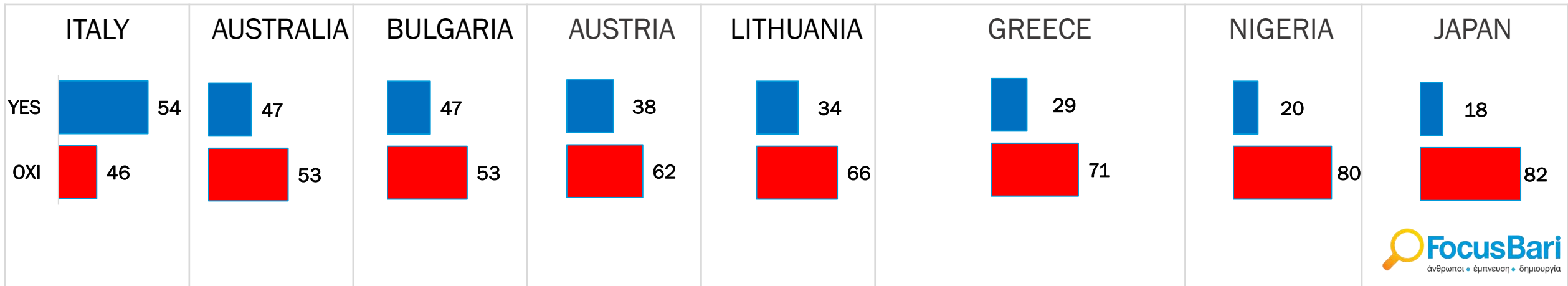
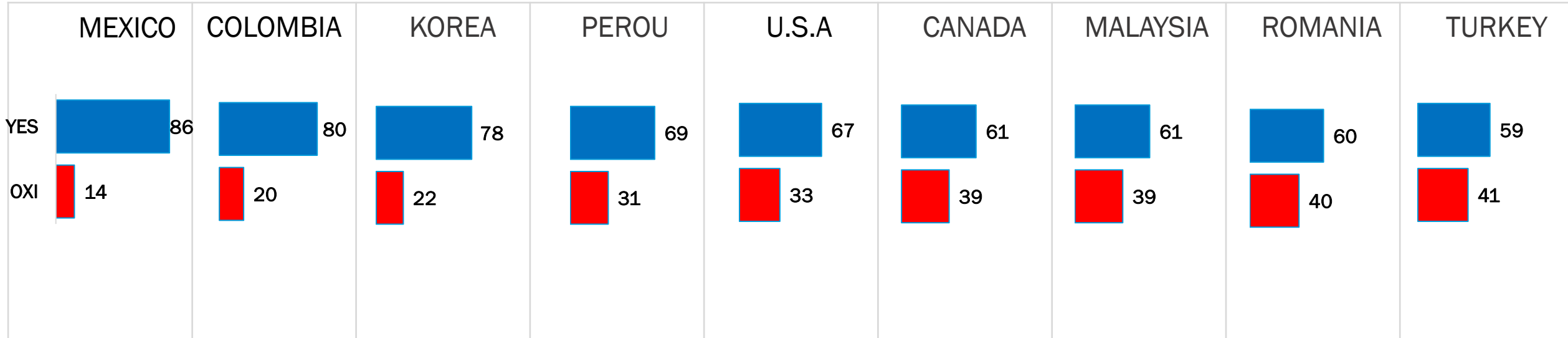

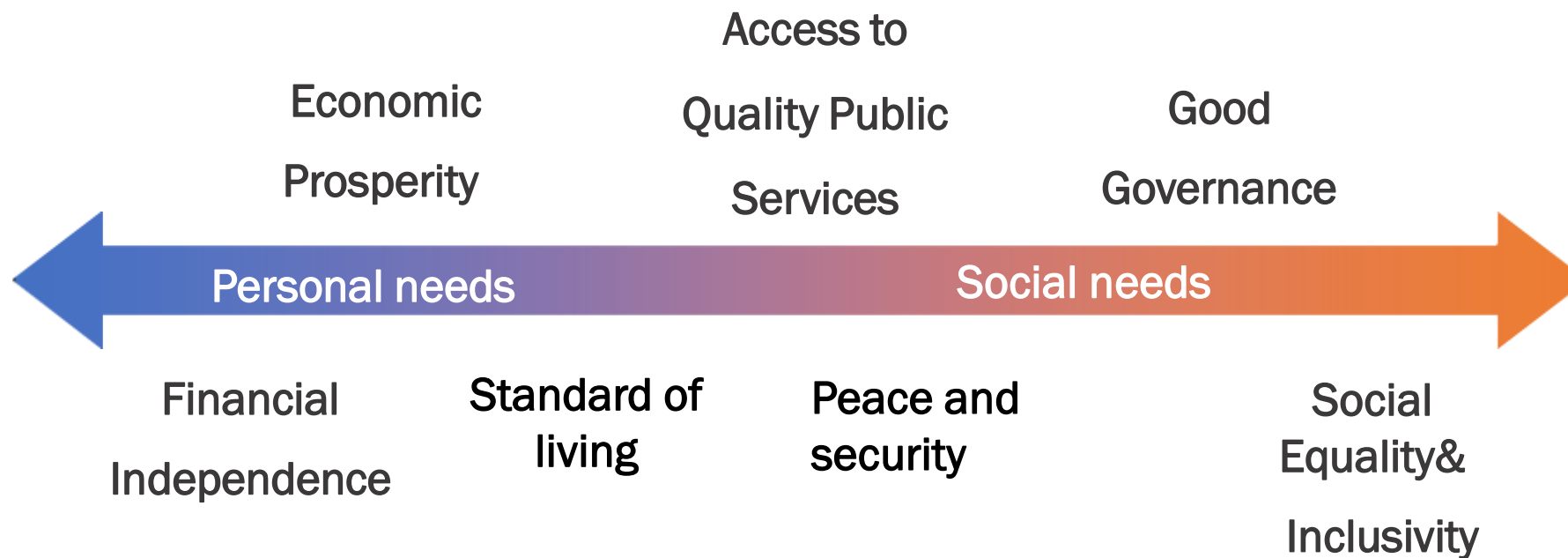
On average, more than one in two (55%) citizens of all countries believe they have a common dream as a nation, this varying greatly depending on each country's culture

However, a desired “better life” is a common aspiration among all nations!

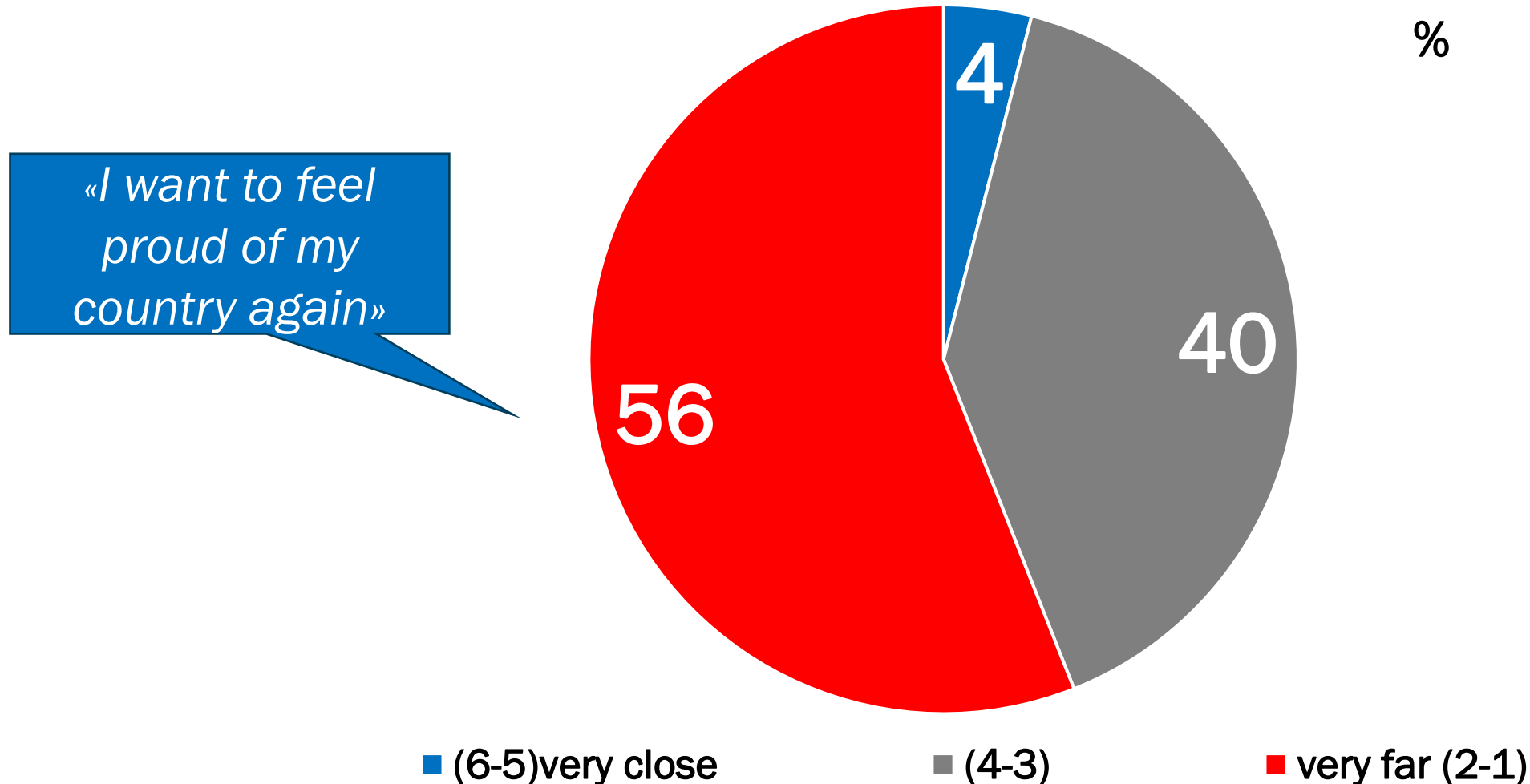
The common dream of the countries included in the study all refer to achieving the conditions so that individuals can have a better life. This goal of a better life is built on 7 common principles:



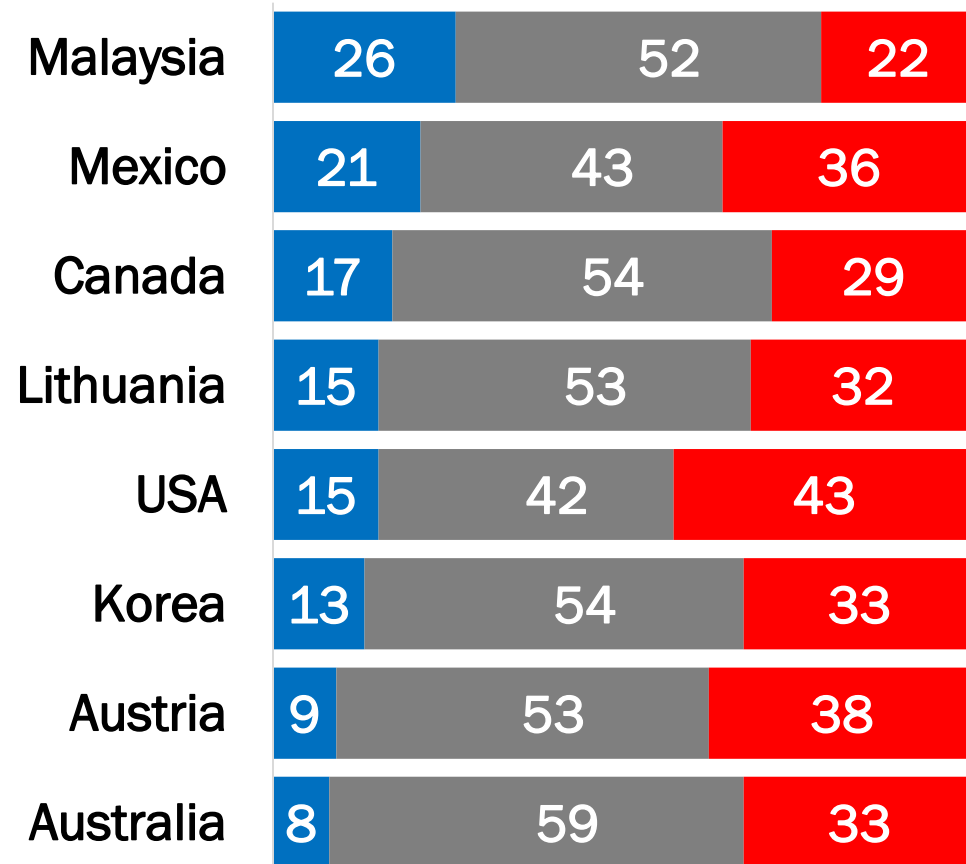
What is your “Dream Country?”

Qst«How far or how close is the Greece of today to the Greece of your dreams? (scale 1-6)



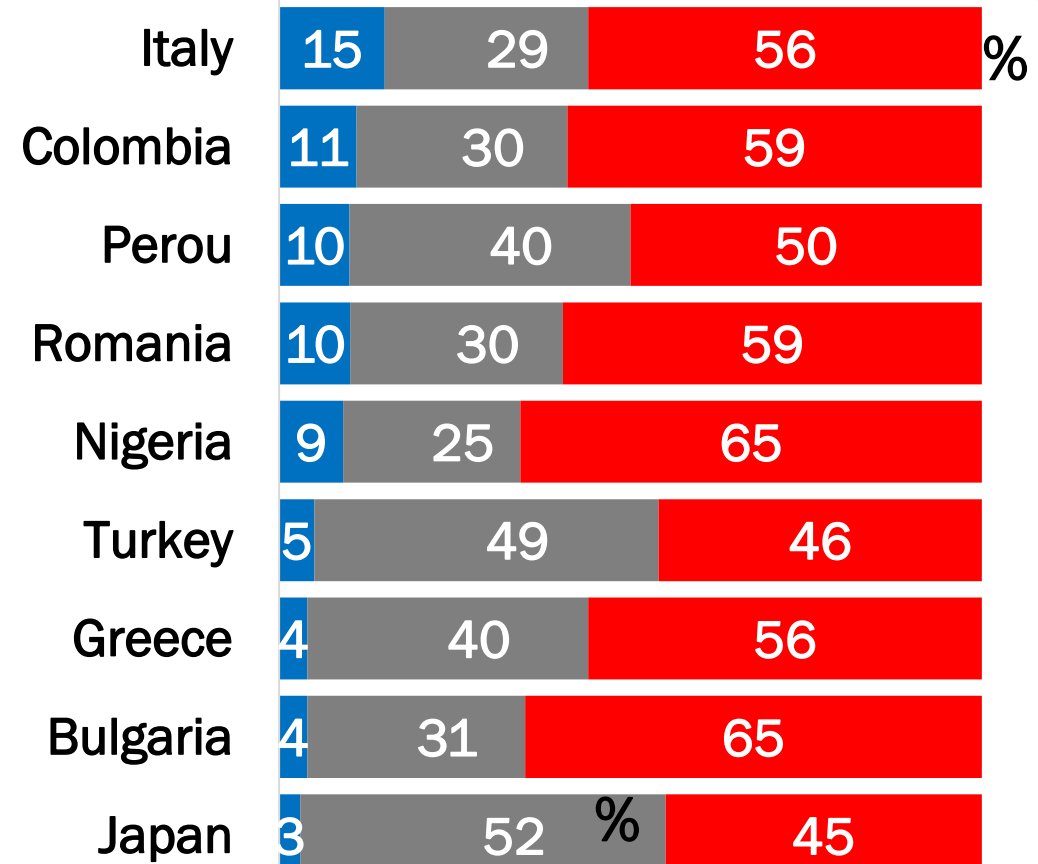

■ (4-3)

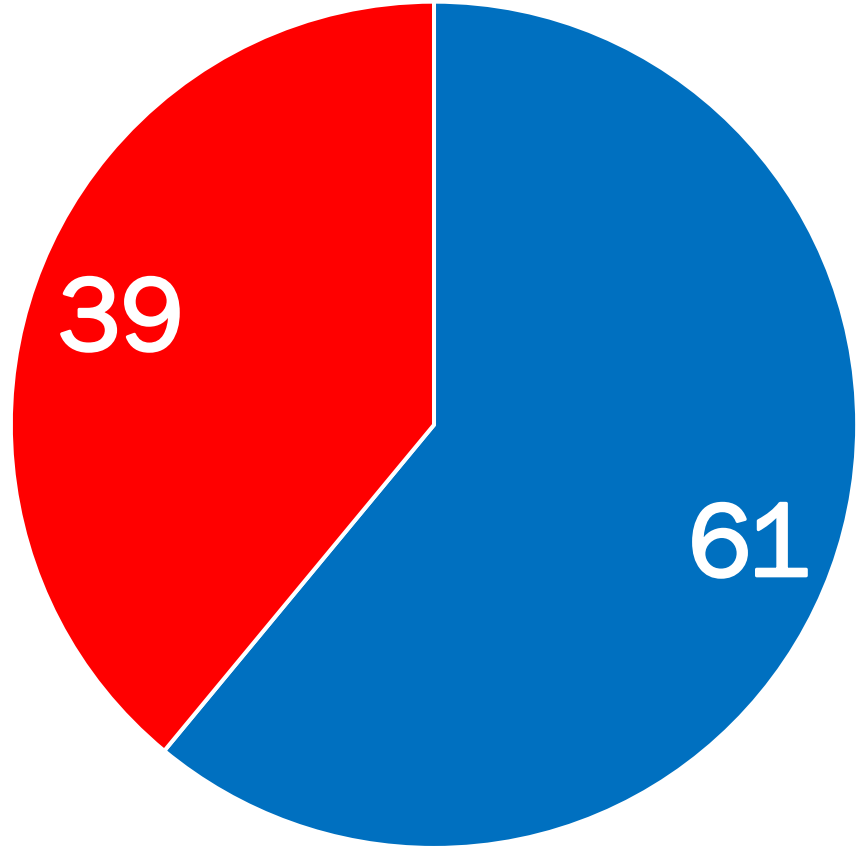

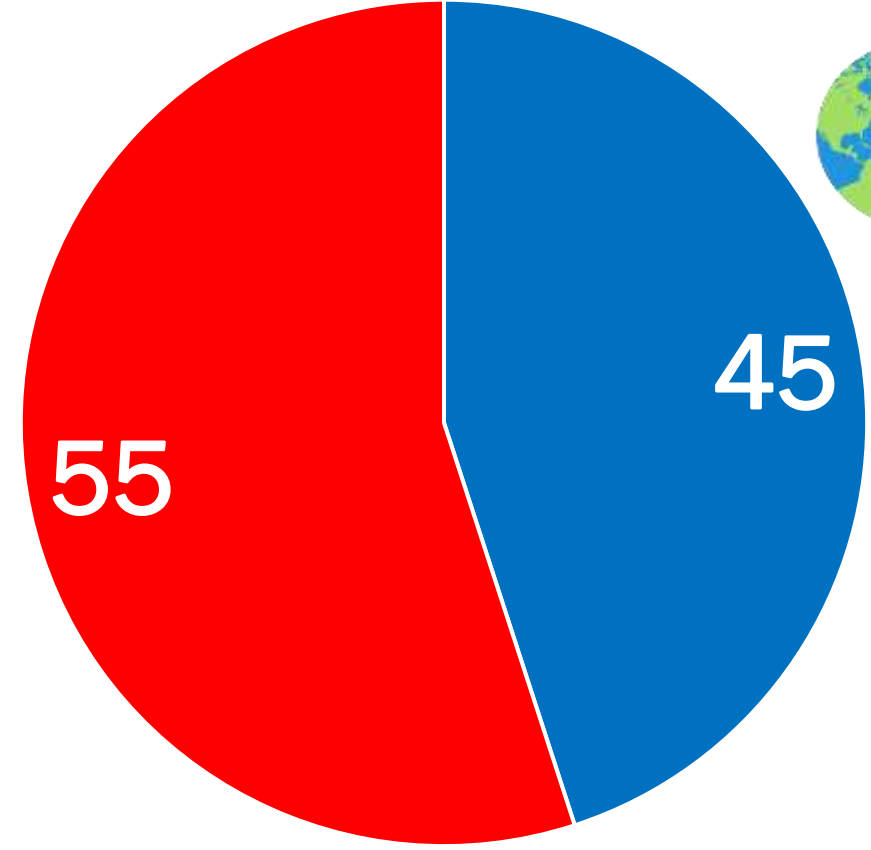
As a result, on average almost one in two citizens of the 17 survey countries would like to live in another country, and this proportion reaches 61% among Greeks!



Qst. «If you could live in another country, would you choose to move?»



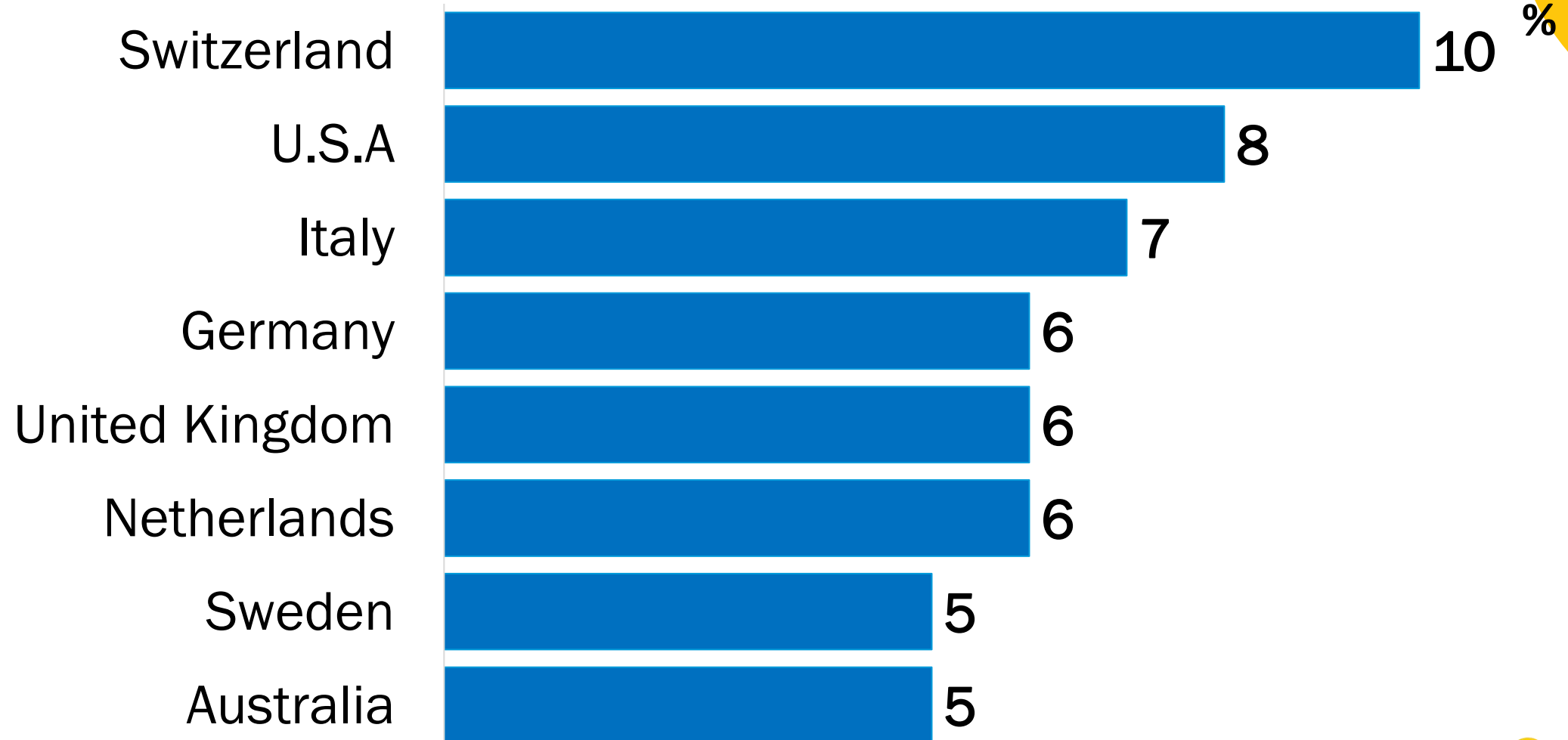

Important «takeaways»

- Citizens, even in the most developed countries, **appear hesitant** regarding their satisfaction with **achieving their goals in their daily lives**
- Despite respondents' hesitation due to the difficulty in achieving their goals, **the current state of their country is not a nightmare for their daily lives!**
- There is a strong need among citizens **for improvement in their quality of life** and enhancement of their standard of living, both **at a personal level** and within the broader context of **public administration and political forces**. For this reason, the desire of all residents, **regardless of country, is to focus more on the problems of their citizens rather than on global influence, is evident**
- **None** of the mentioned countries **offers an ideal life to its citizens**. This explains the fact **that one in two** respondents would prefer **to immigrate to another country** if given the opportunity.

Conclusions for Greece!

- Only **9%** of Greeks admit that **their daily life is as they wished**, and **just 4%** say that today's **Greece is the country of their dreams**.
- Greeks **perceive a lack of cohesion among citizens** in their country, as **7 out of 10 (71%)** believe there is **no common goal and express the need to feel proud of their country again**.
- Citizens believe that **improving economic conditions** is necessary to enhance their quality of life, which is an immediate priority **for overcoming daily challenges on vital issues**. They also **highlight the need for radical changes in basic public goods**, primarily in healthcare, but also in education, employment, and justice, to ensure direct and equal access for all.
- These measures will secure for them **a decent standard of living** and strengthen their morale (to have or be able to have dreams and goals), as well as improve their family life (comfort), which has been affected by the stress of their daily struggle for survival.

Conclusions for Greece

It is worth noting that **58% of respondents believe that Greece should prioritize Greeks first.** To achieve this, citizens believe that the government and central political authorities should:

- **Embrace their needs**
- **Show sensitivity to their issues**
- **Ensure the smooth operation of the country in vital sectors (economy, healthcare, education, justice).**

Greeks believe that if their country adopts its strong moral system (national unity, equality, democracy), it will have the guarantees to stand as an equal member of the European Union.

Finally, it is not coincidental that **61% of citizens express a desire to live in another country,** with a preference for **Switzerland,** a Central European country with the highest quality of life in the world and a strong economic system.
